

In Memoriam: Dr. Harold G. Marshall

Dr. Harold Gene Marshall passed away on the 27th of April, 2019. He would have been 91 years old on May 7th. Being a very humble man, he did not want a formal service held, nor an obituary published in the local paper, but he was a giant in the oat world and deserves great recognition from our community.

Harold was an oat breeder with the USDA-ARS in the Department of Agronomy at Pennsylvania State University. The <u>1986 issue of the Oat Newsletter</u> was dedicated to him (as well as Paul Rothman) upon his retirement. In 1994, Harold was presented with the Distinguished Service to Oat Improvement Award at the American Oat Workers' Conference in Minneapolis. More information concerning that presentation can be found <u>here</u>.
